

Dosage Error in Emergency Procedures for Small Animal Veterinarian

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It was recently brought to our attention that *Emergency Procedures for Small Animal Veterinarian, 3e* contains a potentially harmful dosage error. The dosage error has been corrected in the e-book and all other digital versions of the content, but is found in the print version in on page 139 (#5), "Administer bronchodilators (caution in patients with cardiac disease). Albuterol inhaler: 108 mcg q 30 – 60 min until severe dyspnea resolves or terbutaline 0.1 mg/kg IM/SC up to q4h until severe dyspnea resolves. "

The following sentence is correct:

"Administer bronchodilators (caution in patients with cardiac disease). Albuterol inhaler: 108 mcg q 30 – 60 min until severe dyspnea resolves or terbutaline 0.01 mg/kg IM/SC up to q4h until severe dyspnea resolves." The dosage of terbutaline should be changed to **0.01** per day.
